

#### Match Remote Control (two match ways)

End user can choose the suitable match/delete ways. Two options are offered for selection:

#### Use the controller's Match key

Match:

Short press match key, immediately press on/off key on the remote. The LED indicator fast flash a few times means match is successful.

#### Delete:

Press and hold match key for 5s to delete all match, The LED indicator fast flash a few times means all matched remotes were deleted.

#### Use Power Restart

Match:

Switch off the power, then switch on power, repeat again. Immediately short press on/off key 3 times on the remote. The light blinks 3 times means match is successful.

#### Delete:

Switch off the power, then switch on power, repeat again. Immediately short press on/off key 5 times on the remote. The light blinks 5 times means all matched remotes were deleted.
